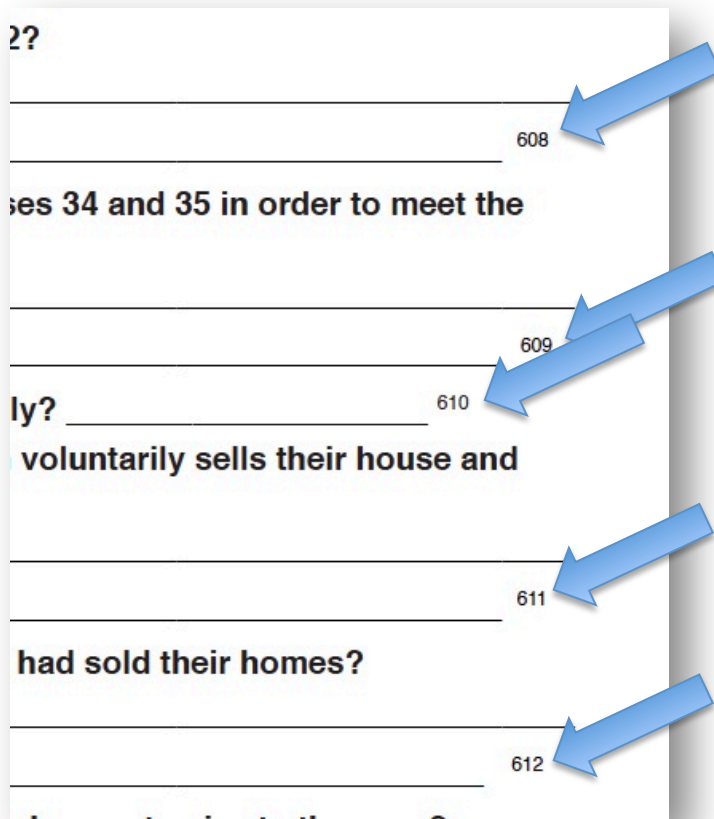


Hi everyone,

I'm writing because I am so sorry so many of you are having a hard time figuring out how to find the answers in the answer key. I designed it to be so easy, but somehow I goofed. Let me explain my thinking to you and see if it makes sense.

On page 196 of the Cat and Dog Theology Year 1's curriculum, you'll find footnotes at the right that look like this:



Please note the numbers “608, 609, 610, 611, 612” to which the arrows are pointing. Those are the footnote references. That number is the key to finding your answer for that question. Once you see that number, go to the *Answer Key* and look those specific footnotes up. They are in numeric order.

In the Answer Key, you would flip through it looking at all of the numbers on the left side of each page. (Do not look at the page numbers of the *ANSWER KEY*.) On the top of page 1 is footnote “1”. On the next page it starts with footnote “25.” The next page starts with footnote “92.” The next page starts with footnote “151.” You get the idea. You would keep flipping until you got to the 600 section. Eventually you would come to find the numbers on page below.



Numbers 608-612 happen to be on page 20, but page 20 has nothing to do with finding the answers. You will find it because of looking at the footnote numbers in numeric order on the left side of the page.

You may ask, "Then why did you put page numbers in the Answer Key?" The answer to that is that it may help you in finding future answers. If you saw on Monday that the answers were on page 20, you could flip to that page quickly on Wednesday and then look for the new footnote number.

I didn't put chapters, weeks or lessons in there, because I thought it would simply take more time to find the footnote that way. Flipping through and looking for numbers on the left side of the page (I assumed—and possibly incorrectly) would yield your answer much quicker. But many have complained that it has been hard to find.

I hope this clears it up and makes it easy for you to find the answers you are looking for. We will put this explanation in the first revision of the Cat and Dog Theology workbook.
