

Hi parents and students who are going through RG3,

I am so excited you are venturing into RG3! It is material that has radically changed my life. I teach on it all the time at Perspectives courses. And I hope it changes your life too.

The process of putting a curriculum together is very detailed. Not only does it have to be thought up, but it also has to be formatted in a way that will make sense. Once formatted, we have many proofers go through it to look for mistakes. Once we think we've found all of the mistakes, we send it to the printer.

Once the printer gets it, they send us a mock-up workbook. We then look it over. If we find any corrections that need to be made, we inform them and send them those corrections.

This is what happened with RG3. We found a couple of mistakes that needed to be corrected. Those corrections were on page 13 and 18.

So we sent them the corrections. But...

You'll notice there are two sets of pages that have the number 13 and 18 on them. The first 13 and 18 are in the "Introduction" section. The second 13 and 18 are in the "Lessons" section.

The corrections we sent them were for the "Introduction" section. The "Lessons" page 13 and 18 were not to be changed. Unfortunately the printer took the pages we sent them for the "Introduction" section and put them into the "Lessons" section.

So the "Lessons" page 13 and 18 (which totally look out of place) are exactly that, out of place! They should be pages 13 and 18 in the "Introduction" section. Here's what we changed:

Page 13

On page 13 we changed one line. It reads (on the "Introduction page 13"):

- two *YouTeach CDs on The Story of the Bible and A Cat and Dog Look At The Cross*

It was changed to:

- *RG3 YouTeach CD* (but this is found in the "Lessons" section.)

Page 13

On page 18 we added "My Dream Timeline.....589"

Because we clearly communicated that the changes should be in the "Introduction section," we didn't ask for a second proof. That was our mistake. But at the same time, the printer also owns their responsibility in putting the corrections in the wrong place. No matter who is at fault, you guys come out confused. Sorry about this. Just to let you know, it will be corrected in future productions. Hope this clears it all up!
